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# Original concept

- Purpose-built facility housing up to 30 general public, researchers, volunteers
- Replaces the bunkhouse
- Comfortable 2-person 'chalet' bedrooms, lounge, dining, ablutions, drying area
- Funded & built by SOTM
- Managed by SOTM, as profit-making venture



# Current status

## Positives:

- Drawings agreed on
- Resource consent in place
- Two independent assessments confirm its feasibility

# **But:**

- Costs have escalated significantly now over \$6m
- Funder crunch in past 2 years
- Less than 2 years until consent expires

### So:

Time to reassess – where to now?



# Option 1 - full centre

#### Benefits

- Quality accommodation for all - more attractive for visitors
- Possible profit-maker for SOTM
- Frees up bunkhouse

# Drawbacks/risks - operating

- Significant SOTM management time
- Currently SOTM has no experience running an accom business
- Potential big risks if we lose ferry company/ another pandemic

### Drawbacks/risks - building

- May be very hard to fund
- Cost escalation during building
- Huge time impact on SOTM to get funding

### Alternatives

- Build a smaller building
- Build full version, but give to another party to run



# Option 2 – Research field centre

Build stripped down version for up to 8 researchers – no public etc.

Ablutions block and 4 chalets – 3 for sleeping, 1 as temporary kitchen/dining Self-managed/cleaned under SOTM oversight.

#### **Benefits**

- Much cheaper to build easier to fund
- Easier to manage in-house
- Meets core needs for researchers
- Frees up space in bunkhouse
- Allows for staged approach

### Drawbacks/risks - operating

- Ongoing cost to maintain without any offsetting revenue
- Still reliant on bunkhouse for most SOTM volunteers

### Drawbacks/risks - building

- Building consent may not cover reduced plans
- Still have to build ablutions
- Still a significant cost- \$2m

### **Alternatives**

Build & hand over to DOC



# Option 3 – do nothing

Status quo - SoTM 'sticks to its knitting', leaves accom to DOC and/or other operator.

#### **Benefits**

- No cost initial or ongoing
- No admin/management time
- No risks to SOTM

### Drawbacks/risks - building

None

### Drawbacks/risks - ongoing

- Ongoing issues with booking/ housing researchers
- Ongoing poor accom standard for SOTM volunteers, general public

#### **Alternatives**

 Work with DOC to find external party willing to build/own/ operate new accom
