Move back five squares.



Tuatara are sharing the seabird burrows.

Move forward two squares.

Rubbish has been washed up on the beach. Move back two squares. You will need a counter each and a dice.





It has been a hot summer which has dried up the dams. **Move back one square.**



A takahē chick has hatched. Move forward one square.
