The Supporters of Tiritiri Matangi would like to recognise an eco-champion, inspired by the Tiritiri Matangi Restoration Project, who is making a positive contribution towards promoting a message of kaitiakitanga – guardianship of our natural world.

The winning student **must have been inspired by Tiritiri Matangi** e.g. visiting Tiritiri Matangi, reading about it, researching the website. They can be primary or intermediate level, and do not necessarily need to have visited the island. The winning student will show the following:

IN THEIR COMMUNITY:

- shows initiative and commitment to the te taiao | the environment
- demonstrates a passion for native and endemic species in Aotearoa
- encourages others to take action for the environment
- can be a leader and role model to inspire others
- perseveres with great attitude even when facing challenges
- shows enjoyment in their role as kaitiaki
- uses initiative to create solutions to protect and/or restore te taiao

THEY MAY ALSO:

- volunteer in community environmental activities e.g. tree planting, pest predator control
- encourage native manu | birds into gardens e.g. by planting native plants
- communicate their knowledge, passion and motivation with others

NOMINATIONS CAN BE FROM:

- teachers/staff members
- parents/whānau
- other adults
- student's own submission

AWARD:

- Trip to Tiritiri Matangi for 2 adults and 2 children - including guiding

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- one student entry per school
- prize cannot be redeemed for cash
- only available to primary and intermediate school students
- excludes travel to the ferry terminal
